4. Marks shall also be given to authors for effecting meaningful and successful conclusion of their presentation suggesting steps to be initiated to eradicate such social evil.
5. Since it is a national seminar kindly note that the authors presenting their papers in Hindi and English shall be entitled for 5 points by default.
